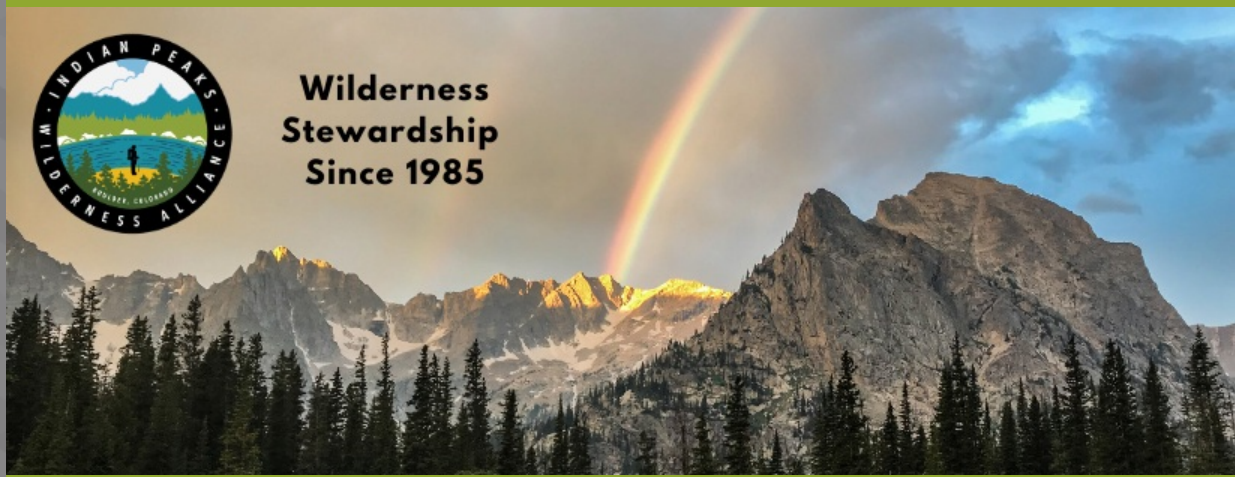

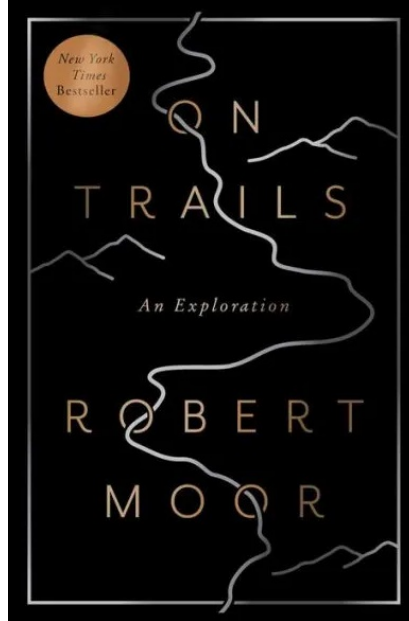
Upcoming Reading Group Event
